Sabeel in Jerusalem

Sabeel is an ecumenical grassroots liberation theology movement among Palestinian Christians. Inspired by the life and teaching of Jesus Christ, this liberation theology seeks to deepen the faith of Palestinian Christians, to promote unity among them and lead them to act for justice and peace.

Kairos Palestine

A Christian Palestinian movement, born out of the Kairos Document, *A Moment of Truth* (2009), which advocates for ending the Israeli occupation and achieving a just solution to the conflict through a global movement of non-violent resistance.

The Kairos Document is the word of Christian Palestinians to the world about what is happening in Palestine.
