'Challenging Apartheid in Advent'

A Study Guide

With the publications by Human Rights Watch¹, Amnesty International² and B'Tselem³ concluding that the situation for Palestinians and Israelis between the Mediterranean Sea and the River Jordan amounts to Israel committing the crime of apartheid, according to the international legal definition, the academic argument has been resolved. While others have written in support of these reports and the State of Israel and its supporters have sought to rubbish them, there has been no thorough examination of the societal situation in this area that has come up with any fundamental rebuttal of the arguments. With the destruction of any possibility of the 'Two-State Solution' by the rapid increase of Israeli settlements in West Bank, the now 15-year blockade of Gaza, and the ongoing restrictions on the rights and freedoms of Palestinians living under Israeli military law, what was a 'temporary occupation' is now clearly seen by the Israeli Government as a permanent situation. For the threshold of the International Law's definition of Apartheid to be crossed the permanence of the arrangements need to be clear. They are now.

But Israel Apartheid is different in some ways to South African Apartheid. It raises different issues and challenges differing perceptions. This study course seeks to look in much more detail at the issues that arise. In the four weeks of this advent course, we will consider:

Sunday 27th November 'Zionism and Apartheid'
Sunday 4th December 'Colonialism and Apartheid'
Sunday 11th December 'Militarism and Apartheid'
Sunday 18th December 'A future free from Apartheid'

Format for the Meetings

A Zoom event will take place at 7pm (UK time) on each of the Sundays indicated. A recording of the event will be available from the following day for use at any time.

Palestinians and International speakers will address the subject week by week with the following format:

Speaker 1: 15 minutes
Speaker 2: 15 minutes
Question and Answer Time: 30 minutes
Thanks and conclusions: 5 minutes

- 2. The Israeli Declaration of Independence speaks of developing the country of Israel "for the benefit of all its inhabitants; it will be based upon freedom, justice and peace as envisaged by the prophets of Israel." Is this compatible with Zionism?
- 3. Many people living in Israel have little knowledge of the situation for Palestinians 'behind the wall' or in Gaza. How can this be addressed?

- How does the Israeli Military effect the lives of Palestinians?
- Palestinians in the West Bank live under Military Law. What rights do they have?

Questions for Group Discussion:

- 1. Britain makes huge profits from the Arms Trade. We continue to sell arms to Israel despite Israel's breaking of International Law. Should Britain maintain its arms industry? If yes, what moral laws or codes should govern this?
- 2. Palestinians under the age of 50 in the occupied territories have never known life apart from living under martial (military) law. What effect do you think this has upon their attitudes to Israelis and the Israeli Government in particular.
- 3. Young Israelis know from an early age that they will be called to serve in the military. They are prepared for this at school and by their families. They often speak of defending their country. How do you think the politics of Israel is shaped by the reality of conscription?

Prayer: You may like to have a time of open prayer and conclude it with the following prayer:

During this season of Advent, we remember the Magi traveling to Jerusalem and on to Bethlehem. Today checkpoints and barriers would inhibit their travel, they would meet soldiers time and again. Lord Jesus you too knew what it was like to live under a military regime. Grant to us all the gift of seeing every person as a human being and living every day by you law of love. Amen

Sunday 18th December 'A future free from Apartheid'

Zoom event at 7pm UK time.

Recording available from Monday 19th December

This week will cover the following areas:

- 'Cry for Hope' comes from the Palestinian Christian Community. What does it say about apartheid and how does apartheid effect the Christian Community.
- Young people have an increasingly active role in Palestinian society. What is their vision for the future, and how do they see the prospect for peace with justice?
- The birth of Jesus even to the poverty of the stable brings Hope. Where can we find hope in Palestine today?
- What is it Palestinian Christians want from the International Community today?

Questions for Group Discussion:

- 1. The numbers of Christians living in Gaza and the West Bank today is a fraction of what it was in 1948. How do you feel about this? Does this matter?
- 2. Given the history of post Second World War history in Israel Palestine are Palestinians justified in using violence against the Israeli Military?
- 3. Is Non-Violence a strategy or a principal?

Prayer: You may like to have a time of open prayer and conclude it with the following prayer:

Almighty God, who in the birth of Jesus showed your love for your creation, give to us that same love for all your children. May we work together for a better world in which people of every race and creed can live in peace. Amen.

Some Suggested Actions to accompany the series

- 1) If you have not yet read the Kairos Palestine Dossier on Apartheid, and the Spring Issue of 'Cornerstone' (the quarterly publication of Sabeel Jerusalem, with that issue focusing upon the subject of apartheid) then do so.
- 2) Encourage your church/denomination to engage with the recent statement from the World Council of Churches 'Seeking Justice and Peace for all in the Middle East'⁶, which calls on its member churches to study and discern the reports issued on Israeli Apartheid by B'Tselem, Amnesty International and Human Rights Watch.
- 3) Consider making your own commitment to no longer buy products from Israel until apartheid has ended. Commit yourself to the BDS movement and respond flexibly over the coming years as more information becomes available that will help us to respond creatively to the BDS campaigns.
- 4) Plan to raise the issue at your next Synod, Circuit Meeting, or other appropriate Church Meeting, preferably with a resolution which will be forwarded to your national Conference, Assembly or Synod urging action (such as a call to participate in boycotting Israeli goods, disinvesting all church funds from companies profiting from the occupation and urging the U.K Government to apply sanctions on Israel as they have applied sanctions to other countries occupying land illegally). This is all aimed to encourage Israel to comply with international law and end its apartheid practices.
- 5) Join Sabeel-Kairos UK⁷, sign up for their weekly Prayer Wave and newsletter and order their most appropriate resources.

- Obtain the 'Investing for Peace' booklet⁸ from Sabeel-Kairos UK and consider joining one of 6) their denominational campaign groups. Visit the Who Profits website9 and write to the body administering your Pension Fund to ask what their policy regarding investment in companies operating in Israel/Palestine is, highlighting those that profit from the occupation.
- 7) Raise the issue of Israel/Palestine with your MP, if you have not already done so, or send a follow-up message quoting Archbishop Desmond Tutu's call for economic sanctions as a non-violent method applying pressure on the Government of Israel until they comply with international law.
- 8) If you are a preacher, worship leader or house-group leader, remember never to use a Bible reading using the word 'Israel' without reminding people that Israel in the Bible is not the same as Israel today.
- 9) Consider visiting Israel and Palestine and stay in a Palestinian owned Hotel or Guest House. Seek out opportunities to talk to Palestinians and learn more about the struggle to survive in the West Bank and Gaza today. The Alternative Tourism Group¹⁰ in Palestine are a valuable resource if you are planning a trip or pilgrimage.
- 10) Use the internet to learn more about some of the organisations working for peace and justice in Israel and Palestine, including Kairos Palestine, Sabeel Jerusalem, Bethlehem Bible College, Tent of Nations, B'Tselem, Wi'am, Al-Haq, Adameer, Association for Civil Rights in Israel and the YMCA/YWCA.
